## Fourth Grade Supply List Conestoga Christian School 2011-2012

Quantity	Item
1	NIV student edition study <b>Bible</b> (copyright 2010 or earlier)
1	<b>binder</b> - heavy duty, zippered, 3-ring, <b>1 ½ minimum - 2 inch maximum.</b>
8	<b>dividers</b> with tabs - do not label - we will do that at school
2 pkgs	<b>wide-ruled loose-leaf notebook paper</b> ---may need more later - I will store the packages
3	<b>folders</b> with bottom pockets and no brads
2 pkgs	<b>#2 pencils</b> - I will store them for use throughout the year. Label each pencil with initials. (use permanent marker) Dixon Ticonderoga sharpens best and lasts the longest. Other pencils do not sharpen well and are wasted, plus they dull the classroom sharpener!
1	large <b>eraser</b> - Pentel white high polymer lasts longer than the pink ones and does a better job of erasing - recommended
1 set	<b>colored pencils</b> (24-36) - these may need to be replaced later
3	<b>dry erase markers</b> , thick tip, black, <b>LOW ODOR ONLY</b> - label
1	<b>ballpoint pen</b> - such as Bic stick, blue or green - no red - label
2	<b>glue sticks</b> - small - label
1	<b>pencil pouch or small pencil case</b>
1	<b>art shirt</b> in a zippered food storage bag - both labeled
2 boxes	<b>tissues</b> - for classroom sharing - Puffs or Kleenex family size last the longest

- no rulers, scissors, crayons, highlighters, or markers are needed (these are available for sharing in our classroom)
  - **no mechanical pencils**
  - no hand-held pencil sharpeners
  - no calculators
