

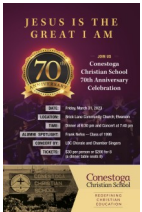

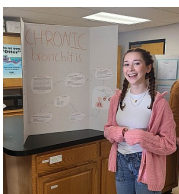
70th Anniversary

Do you and your family enjoy spending time at amusement parks and water parks? You can do both at Hersheypark and support the class of 2023 at the

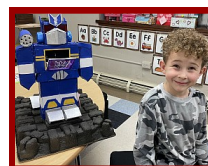
