FAST Round 3

The third round of the FAST Tuition Assistance online application process for school year 2023-2024 is still open. The deadline for completing the FAST online application for this round is Wednesday, July 5, and the deadline for submitting all supporting documentation to FAST is Monday, July 17. Types of documentation requested include, but are not limited to, your most recent federal and state tax returns and W-2s. Cost of the application is \$48 per family.

As the multiple child discount has been eliminated for the 23/24 school, if your family depends on the discount to make a CCS education possible please specifically state that in your application "Family Letter".

- Day custodian. Hours would be MWF (or any combination) from 8:00 - 3:15.

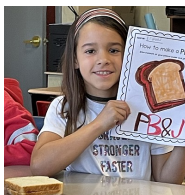
Fitness Challenge
