Drop Off, Pick Up

Student Drop Off Reminder: When dropping off your child in the morning please <u>use only the high school main</u> <u>entrance</u>. For security reasons, we need all students to enter through that door. If your student is late, it is especially important, as they may be marked absent. Students who arrive late must sign in at the office and get a pass to take to class.

Parking for drop off (if needed) is provided in the visitor spots. The numbered spots are for employees or paid student parking.

Early Pickup Reminder: When it is necessary to pick your student(s) up early from school, please remember that you should plan to do that from the front of the school only, and no later than 2:10. (This is due to buses in the parking lot.) For the safety and security of all of our students, the back lot is not to be used for student pickup (or drop off) at any time. And remember, before students leave early, they must sign out in the office. This will help greatly if we encounter an emergency situation and need to know the whereabouts of all students!
