#### Technology News

During online enrollment, all families encountered numerous forms to read and sign, including technology forms. It is easy to lose track of what was in those forms, especially when you read them so long ago. To be sure that students and parents know what is expected regarding technology at all levels, the email with this newsletter also includes copies of the relevant technology forms to read. (You do not need to print or sign paper copies.)

Students need to be aware of the expectations to which they agreed when originally signing those forms at enrollment, so we encourage families of students of all ages to read them again together and be sure that you understand what is included.

Once you have read the policies, students and parents in grades 9-12 must fill out a digital form to submit your acceptance of those agreements to the school. CLICK HERE to access and complete the form.

#### Please remember, each high school

student must provide a case for his/her school Chromebook since the devices go home with students. The case must pro-

vide good protection for the device. Look for a case that fits an 11.6-inch Chromebook or laptop. Cases are easily available at Ama-

zon.com and other retailers for a reasonable cost. Alternatively, students can get backpacks/bookbags that have protective, padded, dedicated sleeves made specifically for laptops. Any student who does not have a protective case or has not filled out the digital form will not be issued a Chromebook.

3. Sign the ONLINE WAIVER that you have read the sports policy in the CCS Parent/ Student Handbook (access through the


