The fall sports season wrapped up at CCS on Friday, October 14, when the varsity boys soccer team finished with a 6 - 3 win over Harrisburg Academy under the lights. The CCS student section along with alumni, family and friends made up the best crowd of the season. The Varsity boys finished with a record of 8 – 8. Earlier in the evening the MS boys team lost a hard fought game 0 - 1 to Coventry in their final game, this gave the boys a 5-6-4record on the season.

The varsity and JV volleyball teams finished their season on Tuesday, Oct. 11 at Dayspring. The JV team pushed their record to 6 - 6 by winning 2-1. In the final match of the evening the Varsity team lost 1 – 3 and concluded the season with an 8 - 10 record. The middle school A and B teams finished up on Thursday each getting wins at Linville Hill. After knocking off top placed Linville, the A team improved their overall record to 9 - 6.

After a number of years of not having a golf team CCS was a full participant in CCAC golf this fall. The boys finished with an 8 - 3 - 1 record and qualified for the CCAC championship match.
