Tuition Assistance

The FAST Tuition Assistance online application process for school year 2023-2024 is open. It's to your advantage to be included in the March round of consideration, so please com-

plete your application as soon as possible. The deadline for completing the FAST online application



for this first round is Wednesday,

March 1, and the deadline for submitting all supporting documentation to FAST is Monday, March 13. Types of documentation requested include, but are not limited to, your most recent federal and state tax returns and W-2s. Cost of the application is \$48 per family.
