## Returning Family Credit

If eligible, your account has been updated to reflect the Returning Family Credit. Eligible families have received a \$275 credit for each PS, ES, MS, or HS domestic student enrolled at CCS as of the end of the 21/22 school year. Please keep in mind that the credit has been proportionately reduced if you have a part-time student, and/or receive tuition assistance.

Families that paid their tuition in full will receive the credit via a refund check.

#### Report Cards


We will be going paperless for the report cards this year! Please look for the orange signature card
